The program is carried out both within Amcha's centers distributed throughout Israel (including Nahariya, Kiryat Motzkin, Haifa, Netanya, Ramat Gan, Tel Aviv, Rehovot, Jerusalem, Ashkelon, Ashdod and Beer Sheva) and at home.
