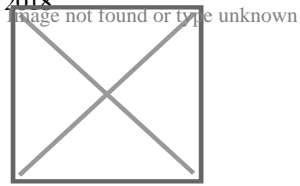
Call to tender for a general contractor for the renovation of Block A-17 in Auschwitz
