




Obituary Marko Feingold



26 Jun 2019

New memorial to the homosexual victims of Nazi persecution to be installed in Vienna's Ressel Park

13 Jun 2019



On Monday, in a well-timed decision coinciding with EuroPride Vienna 2019, competent City Councilors Jürgen Czernohorszky and Veronica Kaup-Hasler announced on behalf of the City of Vienna the location for a new permanent memorial commemorating the homosexual victims of the Nazi regime.

23 May 2019

On 30 April 2019 the period for collecting payments from the General Settlement Fund for Victims of National Socialism ended.
