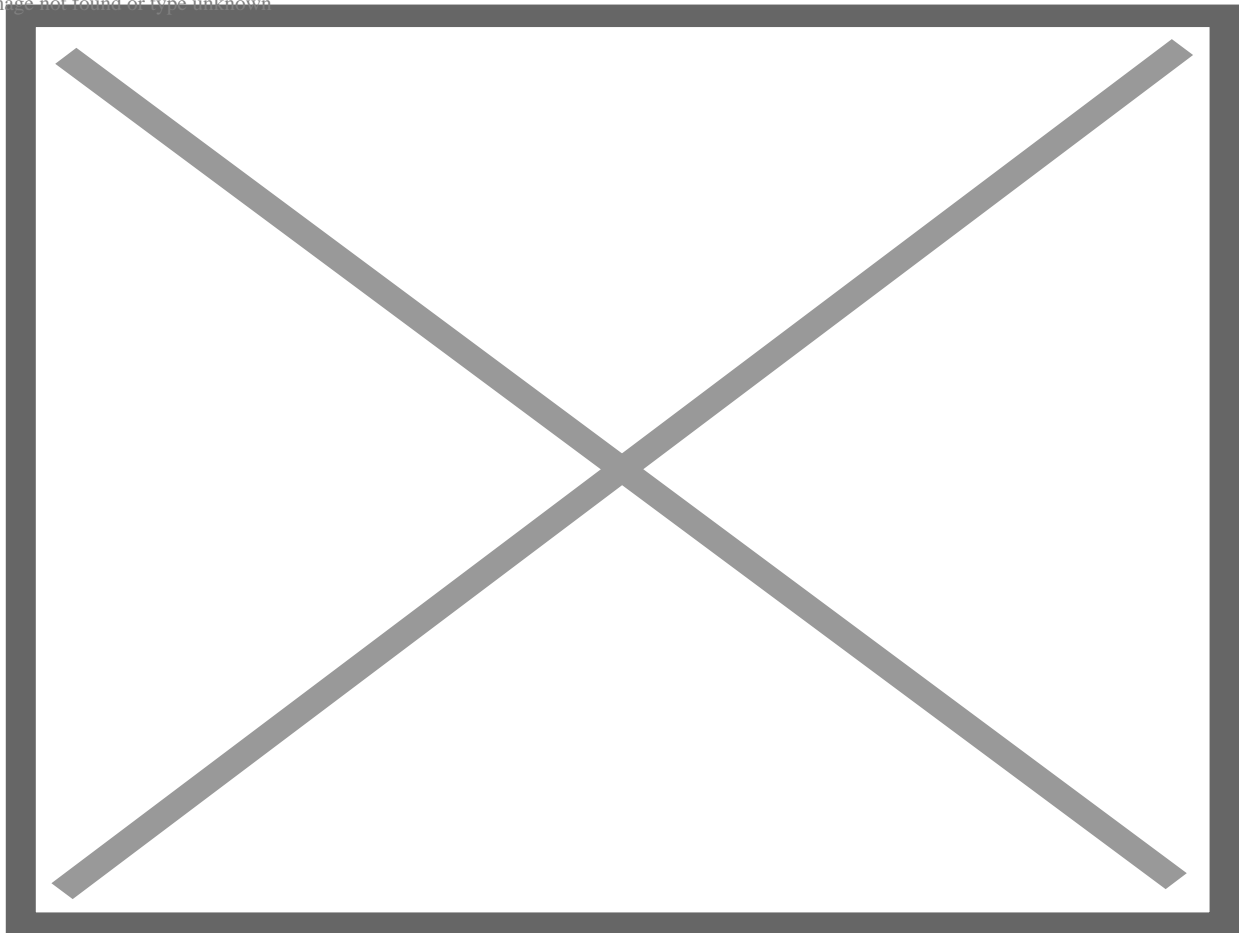

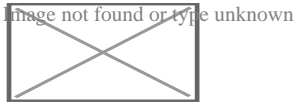

Ten years ago, on 14 December 2010, a legal basis was created for the long-term restoration of the Jewish cemeteries in Austria.

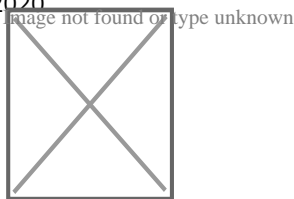
Renovation of the Jewish cemetery in Klosterneuburg completed

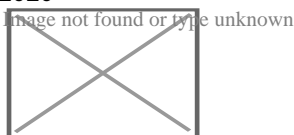

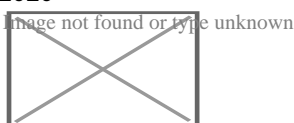

Construction of the Shoah Wall of Names Memorial in Ostarrici Park commences

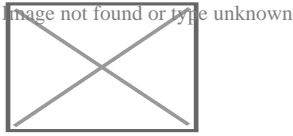

Remembering the first transport of prisoners to Auschwitz 80 years ago

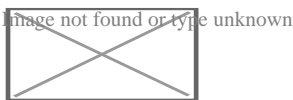

Objects hidden by prisoners found at Auschwitz

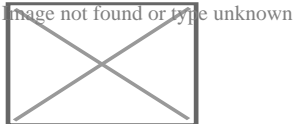
